CODE	DEFINITION-HABITAT	LOCATION
A	Abundant	Expected in substantial numbers in every trip
BG	Bare ground (plowed fields, etc.	
BH	Bottomland hardwood forest	
BL	Bluffs and road cuts	
C	Common	Expected in smaller numbers every trip
CO	Coniferous forest / woods	North of Jugtown Picnic area to STOP sign and turn
CR	Cropfields	Jugtown road drive entrance to park
ED	Edge between forest and open habitat	Drive from stop sign to Visitor Center, Prairie Grove Picnic
Fall	Primarily August through November	
LA	Lakes and ponds	
MA	Marsh area, (Primarily herbaceous vegetation)	Prairie Pothole, Marsh trail, and Photo blind
NG	Native Grasses / Prairie	The Prairie as a whole
O	Occasional	Found only infrequently
R	Rare	Rarely seen
SG	Shrub / Grass type of old field	Prairie View trail (Stripmine trail)
Spring	Primarily March through May	
ST	Streams and rivers	
Summer	Primarily late May through early August	
SW	Swamp area, (Primarily woody vegetation)	
TS	Tree / Shrub type of old field	Prairie View trail (Stripmine trail)
U	Uncommon	Not expected regularly
UH	Upland hardwood forest	Wooded area around the shop
UR	Urban area (farmyards and man-made structures)	Around the Visitor Center
Winter	Primarily December through February
